The goal is to help unemployed people to build their skills, interview technics, prepare CV with them and help with social connecting or act as support person for the unemployed people on courses. For the activity to succeed we feel it needs cooperation with Unemployment Office/Ministry of Labour/another organisation. Connect with unemployed in social media, via newspapers offering Lions expertise.
