Fairmont The Hotel Queen Elizabeth

Our designated hotel The Queen (Le Reine in French) Elisabeth has been chosen to be our Scandinavians delegation hotel (not Island this year, due to Gudruns Chairman status). This old heritage hotel has been newly renovated 2018 and is an amazing piece of history and biggest in town with its 950 bedrooms and 21 floors. You are of course free to live wherever you want, but I highly recommend this hotel it is great and in the middle of everything.

It is also great located with only 1,3 km to the congress center or 600 meter to Centre Belle that hosts the international show and plenary sessions. It also has a subway station in the hotel and it is only two stations away from the congress and one stop to Centre Belle.



The Convention Venues

The Palais - Montreal Convention Centre (PDC)

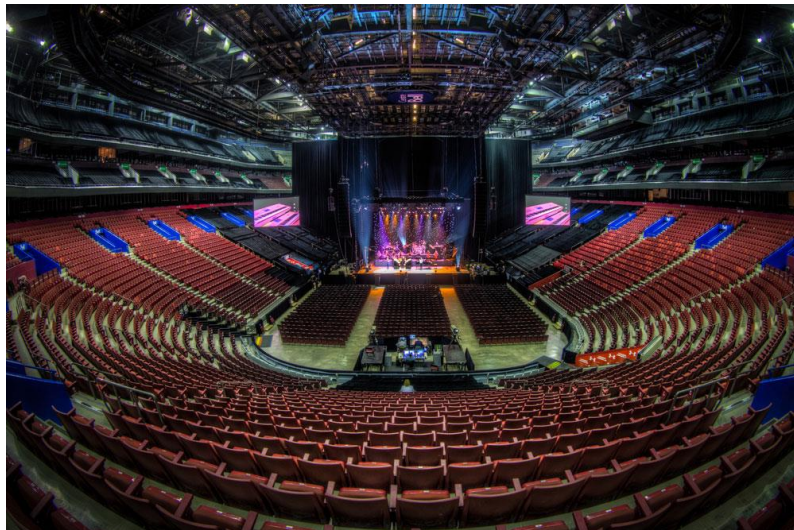
Our convention center in Montreal is called the palace and it is a colorful building in 8 floors. It is great and convenient that the congress center is 15 minutes of walk from our delegate hotel or just two jumps with the subway from our hotel. You go from our subway station in the hotel “Bonaventure” to station “Palace-D’armes” on the orange line. There will most certainly also be shuttle busses for the delegates running between hotels and the convention center. Remember to have the white LCI badge on you if you attend the center before the official opening day 23th of June.



The Convention Venues

Centre Belle in French (CB) “The Bell Center”

This arena was built 1996 and is the home turf for the NHL hockey team Montreal Canadiens. This multi-arena seats between 21000-15000 seats depending on setup and type of event. Centre Bell is the venue for our international show and all three plenary sessions during our convention.



Centre Bell is also located really close to our delegation hotel. If you walk there in 6 minutes (only 600 meters) You can also go with subway to the Lucien-L'allier station connected to CB underground. (All orange line as our hotel and the congress center).
